Catalina Club was first recognised as a 5 hole course back in 1920, created by local Batemans Bay pioneers. By the 1950's and with the help of a series of Groundsmen, including Athol Manns, this grew to the current 27 holes of championship golf we have today.

Each of the three nine's have subtle variances which give them each their unique character. With a continuously flowing creek meandering its way through the land and other naturally formed water courses forming many holes, Catalina offers all levels of golfers various challenges. Set on a picturesque native parkland, an abundance of wildlife also frequent the land offering a unique experience whilst playing.

We have three combinations of 18 hole courses, the Composite Course (holes 1-9 & 19-27), West Course (holes 10-27) and our traditional Old Course (holes 1-18). Many of our championship rounds and events are played on the Old course, which gives players a complete challenge of what Catalina has to offer.

Situated in a temperate climate, Catalina offers superb playing conditions across all four seasons of the year, with major events held at regular intervals.

Catalina is truly a Championship course, but still one that offers plenty of enjoyment for the avid weekend golfer.

COLOURED FLAGS—PIN POSITION

- ◀ **RED** - Front third of the green
- ▶ **YELLOW** - Back third of the green
- ◁ **WHITE** - Middle third of the green
