2026 CATALINA SENIOR OPEN

CONDITIONS OF PLAY

1. FORMAT

- a. The 2025 Catalina Senior Open shall be played over 36-Holes stroke play Tees: Men's White markers and Ladies' Yellow markers.
- b. In the event of a tie or ties for each Senior Medal Scratch event, unless the Match Committee otherwise determines, the winner will be determined by a sudden-death play-off. All other trophies will be decided by the Australian countback system.

2. GRADES

- MEN'S GROSS** Grade and age brackets subject to Field Size.
- WOMEN'S GROSS** Grade and age brackets subject to Field Size.
- MEN'S & WOMEN** Best Nett Daily and 36 holes overall.

3. THE MATCH COMMITTEE

The Catalina CC Match Committee shall have sole management and control of the Event. The Match Committee shall have the power at any time to alter or vary any of the conditions of play. The decision of the Match Committee will be final in all matters and in the absence of a full committee, such members that may be present at the time may give a decision, and any decision so given shall be deemed to be a decision of the full Match Committee. No card will be accepted after the results have been declared.

4. RULES OF PLAY

The Rules of Golf as adopted by the R&A Rules Limited shall apply, together with Local Rules and Temporary Local Rules drawn up by the Catalina CC Match Committee.

5. ENTRIES

- a. Method of Entry: Entries to be completed on entry form and returned to the Catalina Club. No phone entries accepted.
- b. Handicap Limit: Eligible players are male and female amateurs holding a current Australian GA handicap with an affiliated Golf Club (or overseas equivalent). Age: Entrants must have attained the age of 50 years or above as of Sunday June 7 2026.
- c. Field size: 120 players maximum, with Shotgun start on Monday June 8. Sunday June 7 will be a one tee start. Players will be balloted should field capacity be reached.
- d. Entry Fee: The entrance fee is \$80.00 (incl. GST for non-Catalina members). The entrance fee for Catalina CC golf playing members \$60.00 (incl. GST).
- e. Refunds: Entrants who are balloted out and do not make the final field will be refunded in full after the event has concluded. An entrant who withdraws after the close of entries (Friday May 15 2026) will not be refunded. Unless exceptional circumstances are applicable.

6. USE OF MOTORISED VEHICLES

Competitors may choose to travel in a motorised Golf Cart, bookings of fleet carts through the Golf Shop. It is advised to make a Golf Cart reservation with the club only after the draw has been finalised. Players may be required to share carts since there will be a two-cart limit, per group.

7. PRACTICE

Practice round will be available from Friday June 5, subject to payment of a Green Fee at the Member Guest rates. Competitors are advised to phone the Club Golf Shop for bookings on (02) 4472 4022.



8. REGISTRATION

Competitors must register 30-minutes before their starting time on each day of play, or risk disqualification.

9. PROMPT PACE OF PLAY

Rule 5.6b will be enforced. Players who fail to maintain their place in the field may be penalised for a breach of Rule 5.6b as below: 1st offence - Verbal warning. 2nd offence - Two stroke penalty. 3rd offence - Disqualification.

10. MOBILE PHONES

When playing golf at Catalina, players may carry a mobile phone, which should be kept on silent and only used with due consideration of other players, eg. MiScore APP or in an emergency.

11. SUSPENSION OF PLAY

The following signals shall apply: Discontinue play immediately - one prolonged air horn / siren note. Resume play - two short air horn / siren notes, repeated.

12. PRIZES

Prize vouchers will be awarded each day: Overall Scratch: Winner and Runner-up and Third. Overall Nett: Winner and Runner-up and Third. Daily and Over Age prizes subject to number of entries.

13. PRESENTATION

A presentation will be held immediately after the results are finalised. Players are not permitted to win more than one major prize.

- The male and female players with the lowest stroke score after 36 holes, shall be their respective Catalina Senior Open Champion.
- The male and female players with the lowest nett score after 36 holes, shall be their respective Catalina Senior Open Handicap Champion.
