THE IDEALS OF MEMBERSHIP

Golf relies on the integrity of the individual to follow the rules of Golf and to show respect and courtesy to other players.

The Club expects Members to show the same consideration for others when in the Clubhouse. Our Club will be judged on the behaviour of its members and its effects on the enjoyment of the game. The Club expects visitors to share the same standards of conduct.

This document is primarily concerned with the golfing activities of the Club. The Board of Directors of the Club has issued a number of By-laws that affect the conduct of golf at this Club, which are:

BY-LAW 9 Rules of the Course

BY-LAW 10 Owning and Driving a Cart

BY-LAW 11 Junior and Cadet Golf

BY-LAW 22 MiClub Online Competition Golf Booking

The Board has also sanctioned a Code of Conduct for Members, Guests and Visitors which applies both inside and outside the Clubhouse. Current versions of these documents are to be found on the Club website and can also be read at Reception and the Golf Shop. Should this document be at variance to them, the current versions will have precedence. Members must familiarise themselves with their contents.

Under the reformed Royal and Ancient Rules of Golf 2023 (1.2a) the Match Committee is empowered to disqualify any competitor for serious misconduct for which the Rules has no fixed penalty. The Committee has not at the time of writing chosen to introduce stroke penalties

for lesser misconduct, but this may change in the future. Please note that events and dates in this document are subject to change, please check the Club website regularly.

DRESS STANDARDS

Club dress regulations have been developed by your Board to achieve a satisfactory club standard. Members and their guests not correctly attired will be asked to leave the course or Clubhouse. Regulations regarding dress code are displayed in the Clubhouse and Golf Shop.

NOTE:

1. Persons not complying will not be permitted on the course or in the clubhouse.
2. Caddies and persons accompanying members must adhere to dress regulations. Members are responsible for the dress and conduct of their guest. Anyone wrongly attired may be required to leave the course.

RULES OF THE COURSE

1. Members, Guests and Visitors are required to report to the Golf Shop before playing the course or using any practice facility. Members are required to carry their current Membership card at all times.
2. All competition golf will be conducted according to the R&A / USGA Rules of Golf.
3. Only packaged alcohol purchased at the Club may be taken onto the course.

4. The Catalina Club dress code must be adhered to by all Golfers.
5. Greens team have right of way on the course at all times.
6. Members transiting the course must give way to those playing the course. It is forbidden for any member not playing golf to be travelling opposite to the direction of play on, or adjacent to, a fairway if in range of a shot being played.
7. Players are not to hit up on preceding players, but should at all times be ready to play without delay. Nobody should move, speak or stand close to or directly behind the ball or the hole when a player is addressing the ball or making a stroke.
8. Bunker rakes are to be returned to the base of the bunker, and where practicable away from the normal line-of-play. Players must rake divots, smooth footprints and leave the bunker as they expect to find it. Enter and leave only on the low side of a bunker and do not walk on its face unless it is unavoidable.
9. Players searching for a ball should signal the following group to pass through as soon as it is apparent that the ball is lost, and not after the three minutes search time has elapsed. Players must not continue until those who were following have passed through and are out of range.
10. Groups must remain in contact with the group in front. Failing this, the group behind are within their right to be expected to be called through to maintain flow on the golf course. The group overtaken must not play on until the group in front are out of range.
11. The playing of a second ball (a maximum of two) is permitted in a practice round provided there are not more than two players in the group – three or more players can only hit one ball each.

12. Motorised Golf Carts must remain a clear distance, 10 metres, from all tees, greens and bunkers, unless on a formed path. Carts must not be driven over mounds to preserve these delicate areas. Authorised Cart owners and second drivers of carts must be familiar with By-law 10.
13. Buggies, bags or carts are to be left on the exit side of the green and must not be parked directly in front of the green whilst putting. When play of the hole has been completed and any damage to the green repaired, players must immediately leave the area from the rear or from the side of the putting green.
14. All players are to carry and use sand to repair any player damage caused or observed around the course.
15. Use of the Driving Range must be in accordance with the displayed rules.
16. Players will not use profane or abusive language, throw or break their clubs, wilfully damage the course in any way, or criticise the course, the competition, or club officials.
17. **MOBILE PHONES** – May only be used for the purposes of Scoring and playing the game in accordance of the MiScore App and in the case of emergencies with due consideration of other golfers.

THE PACE OF PLAY

It is not the intention of these guidelines to penalise players, but to bring to player's attention the accepted methods whereby they can improve their pace of play and avoid inconveniencing other players who also wish to enjoy their golf.

It is expected that a round of golf at Catalina Club should not take more than 2 hours for 9 holes and 4 - 4¼ hours for 18 holes. In the Rules of Golf, Rule 5.6 is relevant to the pace of play. A player who does not abide by the Rules may be disqualified. Slow play causes great frustration to all the other players on the course. For everyone's sake, let us avoid it by:

1. Not starting a round early: this causes hold-ups in the flow of play. This may be waived by the Starter.
2. Sticking to your booking time and allowing the group in front the allotted interval between tee-times.
3. Maintaining your place in the field. Remember, your place in the field is immediately behind the group in front and not in front of the group behind.
4. Playing "Ready Golf":
 - Move briskly to your ball between shots, while being mindful of your safety and the safety of those around you. Being ready to play your shot when it is your turn is key to ensuring everyone gets around the course in an adequate speed.
 - If you are a shorter hitter play first from the tee or fairway if longer hitters are having to wait while maintaining a safe position in relation to other players on the course

- Play your tee shot if the person with the honour is not ready to play
 - Play your shot before helping someone to look for a lost ball (remember 3 minutes is the maximum time to search for a lost ball)
 - If a ball is known to be in a penalty area do not waste time trying to retrieve it at the expense of the following players
 - Play or putt out of turn when it is appropriate to do so
5. Time efficiency on the green. When you reach the green, move to your ball and repair any pitch marks. Where possible, line up your putt prior to your turn to putt.

CHILDREN ON THE COURSE

In the interest of safety, children under the age of ten (10) years are not permitted on or about the playing area (including the practice area) of the golf course, unless they are either under the immediate care and supervision of an adult, or they are a Junior / Cadet Member of Catalina Club. However, the senior staff in the Golf Shop may grant exemption to such children who are playing members of another registered golf club. When in a cart, children must remain seated, and under no circumstance will a child drive a cart, unless otherwise authorised by the Director of Golf.

DOGS NOT PERMITTED

Dogs are not allowed onto the golf course or into the

Clubhouse. This restriction does not apply to Guide Dogs and other special needs dogs.

CATEGORIES OF GOLFING MEMBERSHIP & RESPONSIBILITIES

ADULT GOLFING MEMBERSHIPS

All applications for adult golfing membership must be by persons proposed and seconded by two golfing members. Membership can only be granted by the Board of Directors.

CADET & JUNIOR MEMBERSHIPS

Elevation of a Cadet to Junior membership will be based on the recommendation of the Junior Golf Committee that the Cadet has reached an adequate standard. This approval is also required for a new Junior member joining the Catalina Club, having previously been a member elsewhere. Cadet membership is administered by the Junior Golf Committee.

RESPONSIBILITY FOR NEW MEMBERS

It is the responsibility of the Proposer and Secunder immediately a Nominee is elected to membership, to ensure that such new member is

- i. introduced to the President, Captain and other members;
- ii. above all, is sufficiently advanced in the knowledge of the Rules of Golf to be competent to perform the duty of marker to a fellow competitor. Please see that you play with your Nominee until he or she is so equipped.

BOOKING SHEETS & STARTING TIMES

See also By-law 22.1 Computerised booking for competition or social golf (MiClub software) is available online via the Club's website or the Golf Shop.

1. To gain online access to time sheets, members log in via www.catalinaclub.com.au, and go to "Golf", "Golf Members Login". All events which are currently open for reservation are then displayed.
2. Timesheets are opened at 6:00pm, 8 days before the event. Variations may occur for Special Events.
3. Online booking and cancellation is possible at any time preceding play except for Special Events.
4. Certain Events may require the submission of an entry form with a pre-paid fee.
5. Competitors who are unable to meet their Tee Time on the day of that event for which they are booked must remove themselves from the timesheet as soon as possible and contact the Golf Shop.
6. The time of a booking on the MiClub system will be taken as the player's start time (R&A 5.3(a)), subject to possible variation by the Starter. A player who arrives late may be permitted to play the competition at a later available time at the discretion of the Starter.
7. A Golfing Member may invite guests onto the course. The number of guests permitted on any given day will not be restricted; however, numbers may be constrained to ensure fellow members are not disadvantaged. Members are only permitted to use their guest access privilege reflective of their membership category. If a member wishes to bring multiple guests to play in a single formal competition the member concerned must apply to the Captain

or Director of Golf. Guests within a member's yearly allowance of 12 will enjoy discounted green fees. The member is still free to invite more guests, but without any discounts. A guest's attendance on the course may be in a competition or as a social player: in either case, the guest must be in the same playing group as their inviting member, which may cover a number of tee times simultaneously booked. If a guest enters the Clubhouse, they must be accompanied by the inviting member and must be signed in by them.

8. Members of the Catalina Club Professional Golf staff and visiting Professionals with a Golf Australia Handicap are welcome to play in all club competitions and are eligible to win daily prizes. They are not eligible to win Trophies in Club Tournaments, Championships, Monthly Medals or Honour Board events.

COMPETITIONS

The Captain or Director of Golf, with guidance from the Golf Operations Committee, has control of competition play at all times, and reserves the right to alter the programme and conditions of play. On competition days the following conditions of play will apply:

- The Royal and Ancient Rules of Golf will apply to all competitions.
- The Captain or Director of Golf will determine the number of players to constitute a competition.
- The Starter may be designated by the Captain; if not then the senior Golf Shop staff will be the Starter.
- Grades will be determined by the number of players in the daily competition.
- Players are required to acquaint themselves with the current local rules – changes will be posted on noticeboards.
- Competition scorecards or MiScore lodgement are to be submitted within 15 minutes of completing the round. Failure to return a score may lead to disqualification.
- Players who start a day's play but then withdraw solely because of inclement weather will not be permitted to restart play later in more favourable conditions – except as covered by Rule 5.7.
- All matches must be played on or by the dates set down unless otherwise sanctioned by the Club Captain or Director of Golf.
- Members competing in Match Play events may not play in any other competition at the same time without the express permission of the Captain or Director of Golf.

- Ties in scratch events will be decided under conditions determined by the Golf Operations Committee or as set out in Conditions of Play.
- Ties in all 18 Hole handicap events will be decided by the Australian count back system:
 1. Best net score over the last 9 holes on the card (half handicap). If still tied:
 2. Best net score over the last 6 holes on the card (one third handicap). If still tied:
 3. Best net score over the last 3 holes on the card (one sixth handicap). If still tied:
 4. Hole by hole count back from the 18th (Indexing to determine shots)
 5. Ties in 36 or 72 Hole events: the last 18 holes will be used. If still tied, proceed as above.
 6. Ties in yearly Eclectic events will be decided on a countback over the last 18 holes, 9 holes, 6 holes, 3 holes then individual starting back from the 27th.

MATCH PLAY

Events all square at the 18th must continue until decided reapplying the handicapping difference.

RULES FOR USE OF GOLF CARTS

1. Golf Carts may be used in any Club competition.
2. Any person wishing to use private motorised vehicles MUST apply to the General Manager for approval (conditions can be found on the Catalina Club website). Each application will be considered on merit.
3. The considerable increase in the use of motorised transport has caused the Board to examine ways of minimizing harm to the course and interference to other players. Vehicles must, therefore, meet the club's minimum standards with regard to:
 - Silencing (electrically driven vehicles are the only vehicles accepted), and,
 - Potential to cause damage to the course (weight and wheel width are critical to this assessment).
 - Standards and specifications have been determined and are available on request.
 - Any new application by a member seeking permission to use private motorised transport must comply with these standards.
4. Motorised golf carts must remain a clear distance, 10 metres, from all tees, greens and bunkers. Carts must not be driven over mounds to preserve these delicate areas.
5. Failure to comply with the above will result in motorized golf cart privileges being withdrawn.
6. Motorised golf carts should not be left unattended in any areas that limit access to entrances, walkways and pathways.
7. Motorised golf carts are to be driven at a speed that is safe, responsible and with due courtesy to all other members.

8. Drivers of motorised golf carts must have a valid NSW Roads and Maritime Services (RMS) or state/territory equivalent driver's licence, unless authority given by the Board of Directors or Director of Golf.
9. To maintain a consistent and professional appearance of the course, and surrounds, golf carts must remain free of any signage, advertisements, or political, personal or commercial messages. This includes company logos, branding or sporting affiliations unrelated to Catalina Club.
10. Access to the Golf Shop from the cart shed is only permitted by way of the service path and bridge provided (do not drive across the 18th fairway).
11. Keys should be removed from fleet motorized golf carts when the vehicle is not in use. Keys for hire vehicles must be returned to the Golf Shop immediately after the game is completed.
12. Special consideration to these rules is only applicable to those members that have applied in writing for a 'Special Mobility Cart Exemption'.

FAILURE TO COMPLY WITH THESE RULES COULD RESULT IN THE WITHDRAWAL OF THE PRIVILEGE OF MOTORISED GOLF CART TRANSPORTATION.

COMPETITION EVENTS & HOW THEY ARE PLAYED AT CATALINA CLUB

1. **MEDLEY EVENTS** – Events labelled as “Medley” in this Fixtures Guide means that both genders may make an entry on that time sheet. Dependant on numbers, there may be separate competitions for men and ladies.
2. **2BBB EVENTS (STABLEFORD, PAR)** – These events will be played as an Individual Stableford event with a novelty event in conjunction, 2BBB Stableford. These events will be scored individually with the MiClub system to determine the Teams Score.
3. **FOURBALL STROKE** – Played similarly to Fourball Stableford and Par except that the best gross score is recorded for each hole with scoring based off the best nett result between the players.
4. **FOURSOMES** – Two players play as partners and use one ball. The partners hit off from alternate tees and thereafter strike the ball alternately during the play at each hole. Handicap allowance is 1/2 of combined handicaps.
5. **MIXED FOURSOMES** – Mixed Foursomes are played in the same manner as Foursomes except that the Ladies use their own tees and tee from the even numbered holes and Men tee from odd numbered holes.
6. **CANADIAN FOURSOMES** – Canadian Foursomes is played as above except that both team members play tee shots at every hole and afterwards continue with one nominated ball hitting alternately. Handicap allowance is 3/8 of combined handicaps.
7. **AMERICAN FOURSOMES** – Both players play tee shots at each hole, then play a second stroke with their partner's ball. One ball is then selected and play

proceeds as in Foursomes with the owner of the ball selected playing the third stroke. Handicap allowance is 3/8 of combined handicaps.

8. **IRISH TEAMS FOUR BALL** – A team event consisting of 4 players. The Team Score for each hole is the best two Stableford scores obtained by any two of the four in the team. These events will be scored as Individual Events with the MiClub system to determine the Teams Score.
9. **PROGRESSIVE IRISH FOURBALL** – Played as above except that teams may be of 3 players and scoring is recorded as follows: 1st six holes best 1 of 4 scores 2nd six holes best 2 of 4 scores 3rd six holes best 3 of 4 scores Same scorecard requirements as above.

10. DROP-OUT AMBROSE

- A team stroke event played by a group of three or four.
- Each player plays a tee shot on every hole, the captain of the group then selects the ball to be played, the player whose ball is chosen does not play the next shot except on the green where all players may putt.
- Each team member must contribute at least four drives per eighteen (18) holes if there are four players in the group, five drives when a team consists of three (3) players and 6 drives when playing in teams of 2.
- The scorer must record whose tee shot was used on each hole.
- In the General area the position of the selected ball is marked, and each player then places their ball within one club length of the marked position, no nearer the hole. Players may play in any order. Outside of the General Area the rules apply as above except that the placement must be in the

same conditions as the marked position (i.e. Penalty Area or bunker).

- On the Putting Green all strokes must be played from within one putter-head of the selected marked ball, no nearer the hole.
- The scorecard must show each team member's handicap and is to be signed by the marker and countersigned by one other team member.

11. **4 BALL STABLEFORD MULTIPLIER** – Played in teams of two. Each player records an individual Stableford Scorecard and the MiScore system will determine the Teams score by multiplying the individual points scores with each other.

12. **BISQUE PAR** - Played as a normal 'Par' event but players may choose where they use their shots. Shots may be chosen to use after completion of the hole.

13. **MULTI TEE EVENTS** – At Catalina Club, players in Club competitions (excluding medal and championship events) may nominate to play their competition from one of the 4 tee boxes, Blue, White, Red or Yellow. Handicaps will vary according to Tee choice.

We have also made a 'Green' Course available.

Distances for our Green course will be as follows –

- **PAR 5'S** – around 300 metres
- **PAR 4'S** – around 200 metres marker
- **PAR 3'S** – from the existing Yellow Par 3 markers

RULES OF PLAY – Green Tee competitions will only be arranged for all players on selected days at the discretion of the Club Captain and Section Captains for their Section events.

- Veterans Section will have the option of playing the Green Course in competition play for players with a minimum GA handicap of 30.
- Only one course will be set up for Tournaments, Championship and Medal rounds.

- Nearest the Pins (NTP) will only be available from the Blue or White tees for the men and from Blue, White, Red and Yellow for the ladies. NTP's in Green or Yellow Tee only competitions will be available from those Tees.
- Recognition of Great Scores (Albatross and Eagles) will not apply from the Green Tee
- Holes in One will only be recognised on Par 3 holes.
- Eclectic Events - Any member choosing to play off the forward tee will be ineligible to win the Eclectic
- Competition hole indexes will be reflective of coloured tee chosen.

Leading 4 players in the Gross Championship will be seeded for the final round.

The top 8 gross scores in all Grades of the Ladies Championships will qualify to contest the Club Match Play Championship. A player declining the invitation will be replaced by the next eligible place getter from the 54 Hole Club Championship. All matches are to be played off the Red tees and completed as follows:

1st Round Wednesday 3rd June

Semi Final Wednesday 24th June

Final date to be determined

Provision will be made within the daily competition if needed to complete the respective matches. These players are not eligible to participate in the event of the day. Matches not played by the nominated date, unless an alternate date is approved by the Captain or Director of Golf, will be declared a forfeit, thus granting a walk-over to the next opponent.

MEN'S CLUB CHAMPIONSHIPS

Saturday 16th, Sunday 17th, Saturday 23rd & Sunday 24th May. Four grades and seniors (over 50's), 72 Hole Stroke, Gross and Net. C and D grade will be contested over 72 holes of Stableford. Leading 8 players in the Gross Championship will be seeded for the final round, together with the leading 4 players of the Minor Grades.

CLUB MATCH PLAY CHAMPIONSHIPS

The top 8 gross scores in all Grades of the Club Championships will qualify to contest the Club Match Play Championship. A player declining the invitation will be replaced by the next eligible place getter from the 72

Hole Club Championship. All matches are to be played off the Blue tees and completed as follows;

Round 1 By Sunday 14th June

Round 2 By Sunday 28th June

Final Round by Saturday 11th July

Provision will be made within the daily competition if needed to complete the respective matches. These players are not eligible to participate in the event of the day. Matches not played by the nominated date, unless an alternate date is approved by the Captain or Director of Golf, will be declared a forfeit, thus granting a walk-over to the next opponent.
