



CATALINA CLUB & MICLUB BOOKING SYSTEM

The MiClub booking system provides Catalina Club members with an easy and convenient way to manage their golf membership details. By logging into the Catalina Club membership booking portal, members can access a range of features designed to support their golfing experience and keep their personal information up to date.

The booking system also allows members to schedule both social games and competition rounds. Through the portal, you can view upcoming competitions, secure tee times, and manage existing bookings or cancellations with ease. This helps ensure a smooth and organised playing experience for all involved.

Each member's Catalina Club golf profile includes essential information used for competitions and official scoring. This profile displays your Golf ID Number, current handicap, and membership category. Keeping these details current helps maintain the accuracy of scoring and competition eligibility.

Members who belong to specific membership groups—such as men's, women's, veterans, or social groups—can book within their designated group times when these are available. This helps ensure fair and organised access to the course for all membership categories.

Members are encouraged to ensure their contact details are accurate, so they continue receiving important club updates, competition notices, and booking confirmations. Within the Maintain Contact Info section of the portal, you can review and update your phone number, email address, and postal information at any time.

Make sure you have your existing Golf ID Number available for when you download the MiClub app. A Golf Link Number is a unique 10-digit identifier for Australian golfers to track handicaps via Golf Australia. A GOLF ID number is now your permanent, lifetime Golf ID. To activate your new account (formerly Golf Link), visit [Golf.com.au/sign-up](https://www.golf.com.au/sign-up) and enter your 10-digit number. You can check your handicap by texting your 10-digit number to 199 GLINK (19945465).

If you do not have a Golf ID Number and are new to golf, or are a golfer from overseas, our Membership Officer will set up your Golf ID Number as part of your membership onboarding. If in doubt, always speak to our Membership Officer first.
