



BY-LAW #12 PENNANT REPRESENTATION & PLAYER SUPPORT

This By-law establishes the principles and framework governing the eligibility, selection, support and recognition of golfing members representing Catalina Club in Pennant golf competitions for the various sections. It is intended to ensure that Pennant participation is managed fairly, consistently and in the best interests of the Club, while recognising the commitment of players who represent Catalina Club and promoting pride, accountability and team spirit across all divisions.

1. Definitions are listed in the Club Constitution. "Committee" means this Committee. "Secretary" means the General Manager and includes an authorised deputy.
2. The eligibility of each player and the selection will be determined by the Club Captain, Vets Captain, Ladies Captain and the Director of Golf or his/her nominated representative.
3. Players will be asked to register for Pennants. Their successful selection will be based on their availability in the first instance, then their suitability to fit within a successful team makeup, taking into consideration the likelihood of other Clubs team & handicap compositions.
4. **Ordinary Resolution 2** as approved by the members each year at the AGM (October/November each year)
 - i. That the maximum allowance for the Members representing the Club for the Financial year 20../.. be set at \$xx,xxx which shall include:
 - Contribution to the Annual Presentation Dinner
 - Contribution towards the purchase of Pennant Uniforms, travelling expenses, reasonable Food & Beverage and Accommodation (to be approved).
 - Subsidies for the Development of Junior Golf.
5. **Membership Category Eligibility** for Pennants Representation:
 - 7 Day Members
 - 5 Day Members
 - Under 35
 - Intermediate - 18 – 22
 - Country Members - ineligible
 - Junior Members
6. **Code of Conduct.** Those participating in a Pennant Event for Catalina Club are required to exhibit exceptional standards of behavior, etiquette and ethical conduct. Players are under an obligation to avoid acts that are unsporting or detrimental to the game of Golf or reputation of our club and must complete their matches in an orderly manner. Where possible, competitors are expected to remain at the host club until the days event concludes and results are announced. Violation of any provision of Golf NSW Code of Conduct is regarded as

unacceptable and may render a player subject to action as determined by the Committee. All representatives of Catalina Club will be presented with the Member Code of Conduct prior to commencement of the Pennant Series.

7. Pre-Pennant Season Apparel Presentation, Ladies to be held at a separate time due to the seasons not aligning:

- Team Season Briefing and Expectations
 - Rules
 - Code of Conduct
 - Selection Criteria and player commitment to the whole season
 - Playing Order
- BBQ or the like, + Beverages
- Photo opportunity for marketing of all Teams/Division

8. Travel Reimbursement as per Section Travel Re-imbursement Policy.

- Accommodation for Finals, if applicable (approval to be sought)

9. Hosting Pennants at Catalina Club – BBQ for visiting pennant players.

- Coffee and biscuits

10. Tuition available from Catalina PGA Professionals. Conditions apply

11. Beverages + Food at Catalina Club for **winning division post winning finals game.**

- Men's, Ladies, VETS, Juniors'
- Exposure in Club socials if they make final and post final

12. Annual Presentation Dinner and acknowledgement.

- Club covers meal cost for Pennant Players

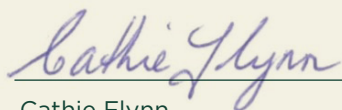
13. Golf Newsletter exposure and communication.

14. Board, Management or Appointed Representation at District Presentations.

15. Each Section/Division to determine Pennant Champion or Lead to ensure:

- Appropriate Communication Strategy
- Team results to Club, preferably on the same day, but no later than 24 hours.
